We apologize for the short notice of this announcement, as well as any inconvenience it may pose to you at this time. After careful consideration and monitoring of the ever-evolving environment around COVID-19, and following guidance from local and national health organizations, **Bridger Bowl will be closing operations for the remainder of the 2019-2020 ski season.** Our last day of operations is today, March 15th, 2020 at 12 noon. This decision was not an easy one to make and has been made proactively for the safety and interest of our employees, guests and community.

We realize that you have many questions and that this news may be disappointing to hear. Bridger's top priority is the health and safety of our staff, guests and local community. With the risk that COVID-19 poses, we feel this is the right decision for everyone.

We recognize that this decision will have significant impact on our employees. They are truly the heart of our operations and the reason our ski area is such a valued part of our community. We are working closely to accommodate their needs during this time of uncertainty and transition, and will continue to pay them their scheduled wages through our planned closing date of April 5, 2020.
