Terms and Conditions

By issuing any pass product, Bridger Bowl Inc. makes no guarantees as to opening date, closing date, days of operation, lifts or trails in operation, snow conditions, availability of parking, or availability of added value benefits.

Pass holder agrees to have their pass on their person whenever loading any chair lift and must present it upon demand for inspection. Failure to present your pass will result in immediate suspension. Skiers/riders, pass holders, and ticket holders are expected to abide by "Your Responsibility Code", Bridger Bowl Inc. Mountain Regulations, Montana Code Annotated Sections 23-2-702 through 23-2-736, and the Season Pass Agreement. Regulations will be enforced.

Bridger Bowl Inc. reserves the right to cancel a pass and/or ticket without a refund and may refuse future purchase of pass and/or ticket for failure to comply with the regulations listed above or disregard for the safe use of lifts, slopes, or other facilities at the area.

For passes purchased before October 15th, pass type is determined by a person's age as of October 15th. If purchased after October 15th, a person's pass type is determined by the person's age on the date of purchase.

ALL PASS PRODUCTS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE.

Unlimited Season Pass Adult, Young Adult, Junior, Child, Preschool, Senior and Super Senior

May be used any day during the operating season.

Midweek Season Pass Adult and Senior

May be used any weekday, Monday through Friday, during the operating season.

Use of a Bridger Bowl Season Pass is restricted to the user whose name and photo are registered with the pass. Any benefits associated with the pass are for use by the pass holder only.

If you have forgotten or lost your pass, contact Guest Services immediately for a replacement pass and to invalidate the lost pass. A replacement pass may be obtained for a \$5 non-refundable fee. Photo ID with date of birth may be required.

All passes are non-transferrable. If your pass is used by another person, you may lose your pass for the remainder of the season without compensation as well as face prosecution for Theft of Services.
